Raíces is a Dual Language K-5 public charter school open to any student residing in New Mexico. It is preparing to start the fourth year of operation scheduled to open August 11, 2022.

The Raíces curriculum is uniquely designed to address the needs of students in borderland communities. Through a Mesoamerican enrichment curriculum known as Xinachtli, students learn to explore, investigate, and participate in constructing knowledge as well as develop, at an early age, important numeracy and science concepts, language skills, cultural oral traditions, and community building skills. Parents participate as partners in creating a learning community where students and parents are valued as participants in the construction of knowledge and the learning environment.

Raíces implements a 90:10 two-way dual language immersion approach beginning in kindergarten. This model provides a gradual learning process of English and Spanish that leads to high level of proficiency in other subjects such as Math, Science, and Social Studies. By the end of fourth grade students will become fully bilingual and biliterate. Each Student form a positive identity through discovering and critically thinking about who they are in relationship to parents, neighborhood, community, ethnic group, and their unique personality.
