Become a Teacher

- Online and in person master level courses at NMSU.
- A co-teaching residency pairing with an experienced Level II or Level III mentor teacher.
- A \$35,000 (taxable) stipend while in the program.
- A commitment to the school district where training takes place for a minimum of 3 years.
- Graduate credits that apply to a master's degree program.

Eligibility

- Must have a bachelor's degree or higher, and at least 30 undergraduate credit hours that meet the state competencies (NMAC - 6.60.3.7)
- A minimum 2.75 GPA.
- Must apply and be accepted as a graduate student at NMSU.
